



What to Expect at a Relaxed Performance

Before the performance you will be sent a **visual guide**



A visual guide gives you more information about the **characters, the story, and topics and themes** included in the performance



You can also do a **familiarisation tour**



The familiarisation tour gives you an opportunity to **see inside the theatre at a quieter time.**



It will include looking around the front of house spaces, the **auditorium** and where you will sit



Changes to front of house areas



There will be **more front of house staff** to support this performance



There will be **signs** around the building **with images** to help direct you around the building

	<p>There will be a chill out space in our green room bar for before, during and after the performance</p>
	<p>The chill out space will have cushions and bean bags that you can sit on and sensory toys and ear defenders that you can use</p>

	<p>Changes to the performance</p>
	<p>The lights in the auditorium will stay on slightly</p>
	<p>There will be a talk at the start of the show where the characters and story will be introduced</p>
	<p>Loud and sudden noises will be taken out or turned down</p>

	Bright and sudden lights will be taken out or softened
	You are free to make noise throughout the performance
	You are free to move around throughout the performance
	You can exit and enter the performance whenever you like

Dictionary



Front of House

Front of house is the name of the area at the front of the theatre

This is where you will find the entrance, café, bar and box office



Front of House staff

These are the people who will help you find your way around the theatre, show you to your seat and support you during the performance if you need it



Auditorium

This is where you will sit during the performance. The auditorium at Watford Palace Theatre has red seats and a yellow light on the ceiling.
