
We're looking to expand our team of creative, empathetic and proactive Assistant Facilitators from the Watford area to support our exciting range of projects.

As an assistant facilitator you will work with a range of participants within workshops and events and help to ensure that everyone has an engaging, creative and safe experience.

Take Part is led by the creative voices of our participants and our work is rooted in an inclusive and collaborative approach. We work with:

- Early years and infants aged 0-5
- Children and Teenagers aged 5-16
- Young People aged 16-25
- Adults aged 19-99+

Watford Palace Theatre encourages, supports and champions participants who identify as neurodivergent, disabled, learning disabled and D/deaf, those who are affected by mental health conditions, those who identify as part of the Global Majority, LGBTQ+ and the intersectionality of all these people groups. We would expect our facilitators to share the same sentiment and/or be representative of this diversity.



No prior experience in assistant facilitation is necessary, you just need to be:

- Empathetic, proactive and approachable
- Passionate about working with people
- Interested in the arts
- Local to the Watford area
- Willing to undergo an enhanced DBS check (provided by Watford Palace Theatre)
- Over the age of 18

Please note that this is a casual role paid at £9.50 per hour. The majority of our sessions take place during evenings and weekends so good availability at these times is desirable.
